ANNOUNCEMENT OF BEEF SCHOLARSHIPS 2016-17

(8th Standard, Matric, Intermediate/technical education/DAE etc., Graduation simple, Professional honor degree, Masters/Post Graduation/MS/MPhil all disciplines/subjects as acceptable, recognized and institutionally affiliated by the public sector so far).

The Balochistan Education Endowment Fund (BEEF) is a public sector company owned by Government of Balochistan and setup under section 42 of Companies Ordinance, 1984 in 2013-14 and operationalized in early 2015. The BEEF under the slogan of “**SAY-YES-TO-MERIT**” is awarding Educational Scholarships to the talented students (boys and girls) of Balochistan. Allocated 80% for Open Merit Scholarships Outreach for Balochistan, 15% need-based open merit under special quota for other parts of the country and 5% need-based under special quota for Extremely Vulnerable Individuals of five most neglected segments of society. Through awarding these educational scholarships, BEEF not only is providing regular financial support to the talented students particularly of Balochistan and generally of Pakistan. The selection of scholars is done after evaluating the eligibility criteria pertaining to academic performance of each applicant in his/her latest annual or two semesters final examination result. Also the BEEF initiative not only is increasing the enrollment by making sure that BEEF scholars are maintaining their attendance more than 75% as well as avoiding duplication of scholarship by confirming that the scholars are not availing any other scholarship from any other organization except from BEEF and this all gets verified by their respective head of institutions/focal persons. Thus, it is worth mentioning here that the efforts of BEEF are not only contributing in achieving the global agenda of Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) primarily SDG # 1 for ending poverty in all its forms everywhere; SDG # 2 for ensuring inclusive and equitable quality education and to promote lifelong learning opportunities for all; and SDG # 5 for achieving the gender equality and empower all women and girls. This all is also contributing in decreasing the drop-out rate, increasing the enrollment and retention rate are ultimately improving the quality education of Balochistan and Pakistan.

In light of the above, BEEF has devised its very first year Scholarship Policy 2015-16 and awarded Scholarships **worth Rs.118.12 million to 4792 talented students of Balochistan which is 93%** against the annual targets of 5286 students Secondary; Intermediate incl:DAE; Graduation; Professional Degree; and MS/MPhil/PhD (one time research grant only) and for more detail please visit our website www.beef.org.pk and Facebook page Balochistan Education Endowment Fund (BEEF).

By keeping in view of the learnings and appreciable experience of 2015-16, BEEF has increased the **annual targets of Scholarships 14682 worth Rs.455.44 million** which are almost three times

double falling under 3 categories **a) OMS** (80% Open-Merit Scholarships for Balochistan Only), **b) SOS/EVIs** (5% need-based Special Quota Scholarships for Extremely Vulnerable Individuals preferably from Balochistan including i) Orphans/Orphans of Shohdas; ii) Students with any disability; iii) Children of government employees BPS (1-6) in service or retired; iv) children of single parent woman; and v) children of labourer / daily wagger earning 12000 or 15000 PKR monthly); and **c) SOS/OMS** (15% need-based Special Quota Scholarships again for Open Merit Scholarships include 4% for students from other provinces studying in Balochistan; 5% for the students of Balochistan studying in other provinces; 2% for the talented private students of Balochistan; 2% for the talented private students of Balochistan; 2% for government official's children studying in other provinces (in service or retired); and 2% students under Centre of Excellence (CoE) no restriction of provinces (listed separately) will cover all over Pakistan. BEEF has announced five Schemes of multiple Education Levels shall award scholarships to the best scorer / performer for example top 40 students for each district (31 districts on equal basis) top 60 for Quetta as an exceptional district due to its significant position of provincial capital comparatively having larger population and educational institutions. Eligibility & Criteria

- Local /Domicile of Balochistan or other provinces of Pakistan as applicable.
- Applicants must be securing at least 60% marks for annual examination or 3CGPA (a applicable) for all five schemes and categories of education levels as given above however, allocated 5% /Scholarships for the students of Balochistan who are studying in other provinces; 4% allocations under Special Quota Scholarships/Open Merit Scholarships for the students of other provinces who are studying in Balochistan; 2% for the talented private students of Balochistan; 2% for government official's children studying in other provinces (in service or retired); 2% students from Centre of Excellence (CoE) no restriction of provinces.
- The all schemes/education levels are allocated 5% SQS/EVIs (Special Quota Scholarships of need-based Extremely Vulnerable Individuals) including **a)** Orphans/Orphans of Shohdas; **b)** Student with disability; **c)** children of government employees BPS (1-6) in service or retired; **d)** children of single parent/divorced / separated women headed families; and **e)** children of daily wage/ laborer earn monthly Rs.12000 or Rs.15000 (as minimum wage rate announced by the Government. The result in 2nd division is acceptable for this category.

- No improvement not failure attempt based result are acceptable for any BEEF Scholarship.
- Applicants must be enrolled and studying or getting enrolled to study as a full time student in public or (private, registered/chartered) institutions of BEAC/BBISE/FBISE/Technical Boards/Universities or equivalent nationally, as applicable.
- Applicant should maintain at least 75% attendance in their current academic year which would be required to be verified by his/her Head of Institute / Focal Person.
- Applicant should not be availing any other scholarship as BEEF strictly avoid duplication of scholarship.

The Scholarship Application Form (SAF) along with Beneficiary Baseline Socio-Economic Assessment Form (BSEAF) may be collected from BEEF office located at Block 09, Room 19, Civil Secretariat, Zarghoon Road, Quetta Email: beefsmu2016@gmail.com or downloaded from the website www.beef.org.pk or facebook page Balochistan Education Endowment Fund. The dully filled SAF/BSEAF enclosing with relevant copies of local/domicile, CNIC self/or parents/guardian, four photographs, credentials/ certificates and/or affidavit for 5% SQS/EVIs category of scholarships attested and verified by his/her respective Head of Institute/Focal Person, may be submitted to BEEF before or by **Thursday 10th November, 2016**, if result of examination 2015-2016 is officially declared. In case examination / **result is awaited**, the same SAF & BSEAF may also be submitted **within 15 days after final annual / two semesters result** would officially be declared during current financial year started on 1st July 2016 will end on 30th June 2017.

The respectable management or nominated Focal Person of all relevant institutions are kindly requested to provide their respective data of result against each category of scheme /discipline / class of year / two semester which are being offered by your respective Institution i.e. University / College/ School. We highly appreciate BEAC/BBISE/FBISE for providing us the required soft data of their officially declared examination results 2015-16 including 8th standard, Matric & Intermediate we already have received which is under review to prepare initial merit lists to be shared/ uploaded on website ASAP. Similarly, the respected management / Focal Person of all relevant educational institutions particularly Universities/Colleges are also requested to provide us their respective data of already declared results 2015-16 on top priority basis. So, we could initiate the process of eligibility review for selection of scholars to be awarded scholarships.
